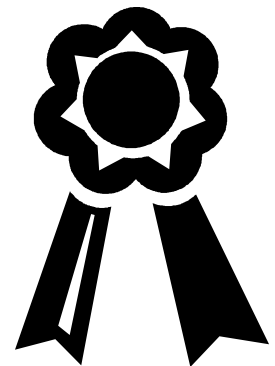

So, we adopted him out to a family in Seattle. This family lost their job and home and felt they needed to do the right thing for Sprite so, they gave him back to WRAP. It was nice to see his eyesight has stayed the same, like the ophthalmologist suggested it would. Thanks to Beth Levine helping to transport him, Sprite now lives in a home in Idaho with a family who is thrilled to have him. SPDR still has available Hugo, the 5 year old 48lbs! blue fawn brindle and white Whippet in Olympia. WRAP is also assisting in the re-homing of a whippet and two mixes with a lady whose husband has a terminal illness.

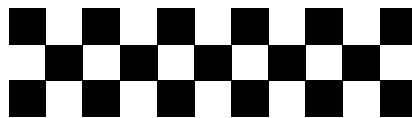
