**Eligible entry:** **NAWRA:** Whippets; puppies age 8-14 months may be entered in the puppy races. **LGRA:** Open to any Afghan Hound, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Irish Wolfhound, Italian Greyhound, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound or Sloughi that is one year of age or older on the day of the meet. **SILKEN WINDHOUNDS:** Silken Windhounds are eligible to run on Saturday in the concurrent ISWS race meet. Per ISWS Racing Rules, they must be pre-registered with that organization's registrar before competing.
