Special prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the ASFA trial for the highest ranked hound in each breed entered in all four areas of competition:

Sprint Racing (NAWRA *or* LGRA)

and

Oval Racing (NOTRA)

and

Lure Coursing (ASFA)

and

Conformation Match

Any hound may be entered in any one event or combination of events, but only hounds that complete all four events, without being scratched, dismissed or disqualified, will be eligible for versatility awards.

FACILITIES INFORMATION

The Polo Field will be used for polo (imagine that!) on Saturday and Sunday and the regular parking area will be reserved for the sole use of the polo participants. Please read carefully and look for signage to the appropriate parking area each day.

All Versatility events will be held on the **PRACTICE** field adjacent to the regular Polo Field. Weather permitting, polo practice will be held on the regular Polo field on Saturday and Sunday. There will be no polo on Monday, but we will stay on the practice field for the Monday lure trial, and make use of both fields combined for the course plan.

Our highest priority is to promote safety, cooperation and goodwill between our club and the property owners and polo participants, as well as courteous and responsible use of their facilities. Please do everything in your power to ensure we are welcomed back for future events.

Directions

From the North: From I-5 take exit #127 (Hwy 512 Puyallup exit) towards Puyallup. Take the Pacific Ave exit (Hwy 7) and turn right. Go south on Pacific Ave approximately 5 miles to the Roy "Y" and bear right on WA-507/Spanaway McKenna Hwy. Go 1.2 miles and turn slight left onto 8th Ave. Go 5.2 miles and (just after crossing 288th St.) turn left into the entrance to the Polo Field on a dirt road marked with signage. Follow dirt road and look for signage to appropriate parking area Do NOT park in the usual parking area, continue following the dirt road to the opposite end of the field.

From the South: Take I-5 exit 88A (Tenino exit) and follow to Yelm. Turn right at the stop light and follow to McKenna. Turn right at stop light in McKenna (Exxon station) on Hwy 702/352nd St. Go 5.3 miles to flashing yellow light and turn left on 8th Ave. Go approx. 3.5 miles. The Polo Field is down a dirt road in the trees on the right just before the 288th Street intersection, and will be marked with signage. Follow dirt road and look for signage to appropriate parking area Do NOT park in the usual parking area, continue following the dirt road to the opposite end of the field.

Entries and Fees

Please send entries to the event secretary listed on each entry form. We are happy to offer electronic entries and payment for ALL four events! Please read the following instructions carefully.

For the racing events and the conformation match, you may type up all the information requested on the individual entry forms in a regular email to the event secretary listed on the entry form. It is not necessary to scan or attach the actual entry forms for the racing events and conformation match. Payment for the racing events and the match is not required in advance; if you email your entries by the early entry deadline, you are welcome to pay your fees at the pre-entry price the morning of the event.

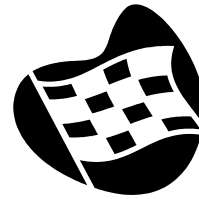
For the ASFA trial only, please see the special instructions in the ASFA premium list. ASFA pre-entries must be paid by the pre-entry deadline. ASFA has strict requirements about entries, and that is why the procedure is different for ASFA entries than for the other events. Thanks for your cooperation!

Electronic payment may be sent via paypal to paypal@wwwwhippet.org. Credit and debit card payments gladly accepted! If you send your payment via paypal, you must add 2.9% + \$.30 to your total fees to cover paypal fees. The easiest way to calculate your fees is to multiply your total entry by 1.029 and then add \$.30. For example, if your total entries come to \$34, to calculate the total including the paypal fee:

$$34 \times 1.029 = 34.99 + .30 = \$35.29 \text{ total to submit via paypal}$$

All checks should be made payable to WFWA. If you wish, you may write one check for all events and enclose it with your ASFA entries, with a note explaining what you're paying for. You may also combine all entry fees in one paypal payment, again, with an explanation of your payment.

LGRA: Open to any Afghan Hound, Azawahk, Basenji, Borzoi, Chart Polski, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Irish Wolfhound, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Magyar Agar, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, and Sloughi one year or older on the day of the meet.

NOTRA: Open to any Afghan Hound, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Irish Wolfhound, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Sloughi, or Whippet one year or older on the day of the meet.

General Rules

All racers must wear muzzles. All racers will be boxed unless the race committee deems the boxes will not accommodate a breed in attendance. Entries will only be accepted from hounds qualified to race. Hounds must be registered with NAWRA and NOTRA to participate. To register in advance see the appropriate website (NAWRA: <http://www.nawra.com>; LGRA: <http://www.lgra.org>; NOTRA: <http://www.notra.org>) for more information. Registration will be offered the day of the meet; for **each organization**, please bring a copy of hound's registration and the \$2 registration fee. However, pre-registration is greatly appreciated by the race secretary – thank you for your cooperation!

Versatility Scoring



We are using a NEW scoring system for the 2009 Versatility Weekend! Grateful thanks to Sue Oace and the Northern California Whippet Club for graciously sharing the tried and true ranking system used to score their Iron Hound Weekend for many years! We hope this lean, clean scoring system will reduce some of the complexity we've been forced to resort to in the past to normalize points across four disparately scored events.

Special prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the ASFA trial for the highest ranked hound in each breed entered in all four areas of competition:

Sprint Racing (NAWRA *or* LGRA)
and
Oval Racing (NOTRA)
and
Lure Coursing (ASFA)
and
Conformation Match

Any hound may be entered in any event or combination of events, but only hounds who compete in all four areas of competition will be eligible for versatility awards. To be eligible, hounds must complete all four events, without dismissal or disqualification. Hounds scratched from any event, for any reason, are ineligible for Versatility awards.

SPRINT: Each hound competing in either the NAWRA or the LGRA is ranked by order of finish in the final results.

OVAL: Each hound competing in the NOTRA is ranked by order of finish in the final results.

ASFA: Each hound competing in the ASFA trial is ranked by total score (total of prelim + final), regardless of stake. For example:

Open stake (score):
Rank 1 dog A 303
Rank 4 dog B 297
Rank 5 dog C 295

FCH stake:
Rank 2 dog D 299
Rank 3 dog E 298
Rank 7.5 dog F 290

Veteran Stake:
Rank 6 dog G 292
Rank 7.5 dog H 290
Rank 9 dog I 285

For the tied scores, the 7 and 8 ranks are averaged at 7.5.

MATCH: For the conformation match, Versatility entrants for each breed will compete in a separate class, which will be ranked by the judge from top to bottom.

VERSATILITY: Each entrant's ranks from the four events will be summed. The hound with the **LOWEST** score in each breed will win the Versatility award for that breed. For example, a perfect score, earned by the highest ranked dog in each event, would be a 4.

Trial Roll Call: 9:00 a.m.

(Early inspection will be conducted after the start of trial hours and before the official roll call time – you are encouraged, but not required, to inspect your hounds early; hounds not present by the completion of roll call will be marked absent.)

Eligible Breeds and Registry

Eligibility: Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Whippets and Provisional breeds, if any, may be entered in the regular stakes. Limited stake breeds, if any, may be entered in Limited Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid and Portuguese Podengo.

All entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with AKC, UKC, NGA, FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a Critique Registration Number (CRN) from SPDBS. Limited and/or Provisional stake entries shall be individually registered with the appropriate registry. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with a hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the National Greyhound Registry.

Regular Stakes

All hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited stakes for the first time must include a completed certification form or waiver (all breeds) and a copy of the hound's registration certificate with their entry (waived for NGA Greyhounds only).

OPEN: Any eligible sighthound, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION: Any ASFA Field Champion.

VETERAN: Any eligible hound whose age is at least 6 years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least 5 years, and Whippets and Rhodesian Ridgebacks, whose age shall be at least 7 years.

LIMITED: Any eligible sighthound of a Limited or Provisional stake breed that has met certification requirements.

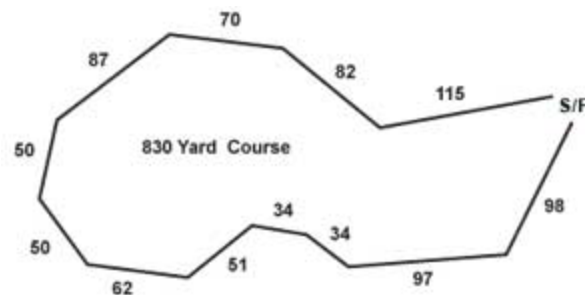
SINGLES: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field.

BEST IN FIELD will be offered.

General Rules & Guidelines

All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial. Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more. Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call. Substitutions allowed only if received by close of day-of-trial entries. Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered; hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Battery-powered DRAG lure machines will be used, with backup equipment on site. The lure will consist of white plastic strips and/or fur strips. A \$5.00 fine will be collected from the handler of any non-competing hound running loose on the field during the course in progress, and from any person not cleaning up after his/her hound. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the site during trial hours. The Field Committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial. Persons exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct detrimental to WWWA, ASFA, Tacoma Polo Club, Roy Polo Field, any hound, or other person will be asked to leave the trial site and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

To offset Paypal's fees, you **MUST** add 2.9% + \$.30 to your entry total. The easiest way to calculate your fees is to multiply your total entries by 1.029 and then add \$.30 to that total, rounding to the nearest cent.
