Versatility Competition

Special prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the ASFA trial for the highest ranked hound in each breed entered in all four areas of competition:

Sprint Racing (NAWRA *or* LGRA *or* ISWS)

and

Oval Racing (NOTRA)

and

Lure Coursing (ASFA)

and

Conformation Match

Any hound may be entered in any one event or combination of events, but only hounds that complete all four events, without being scratched, dismissed or disqualified, will be eligible for versatility awards.

FACILITIES INFORMATION

The Polo Field will be used for polo (imagine that!) on Saturday and Sunday and the regular parking area will be reserved for the sole use of the polo participants. Please do not park in any of the usual parking areas near the clubhouse. Please read the directions carefully and look for signage to the appropriate parking area.

All Versatility events will be held on the **PRACTICE** field adjacent to the regular Polo Field. Weather permitting, polo practice will be held on the regular Polo field on Saturday and Sunday. There will be no polo on Monday, but we will stay on the practice field for the Monday lure trial, and make use of both fields combined for the course plan.

Our highest priority is to promote safety, cooperation and goodwill between our club and the property owners and polo participants, as well as courteous and responsible use of their facilities. Please do everything in your power to ensure we are welcomed back for future events.

Directions

From the North: From I-5 take exit #127 (Hwy 512 Puyallup exit) towards Puyallup. Take the Pacific Ave exit (Hwy 7) and turn right. Go south on Pacific Ave approximately 5 miles to the Roy "Y" and bear right on WA-507/Spanaway McKenna Hwy. Go 1.2 miles and turn slight left onto 8th Ave. Go 5.2 miles and (just after crossing 288th St.) turn left into the entrance to the Polo Field on a dirt road marked with signage. Follow dirt road and look for signage to appropriate parking area Do NOT park in the usual parking area, continue following the dirt road to the opposite end of the field.

From the South: Take I-5 exit 88A (Tenino exit) and follow to Yelm. Turn right at the stop light and follow to McKenna. Turn right at stop light in McKenna (Exxon station) on Hwy 702/352nd St. Go 5.3 miles to flashing yellow light and turn left on 8th Ave. Go approx. 3.5 miles. The Polo Field is down a dirt road in the trees on the right just before the 288th Street intersection, and will be marked with signage. Follow dirt road and look for signage to appropriate parking area Do NOT park in the usual parking area, continue following the dirt road to the opposite end of the field.

Please send entries to the event secretary listed on each entry form. We are happy to offer electronic entries and payment for ALL four events! Please read the following instructions carefully.

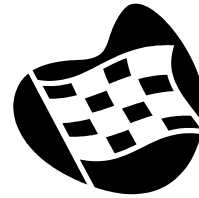

It is not necessary to scan or attach the actual entry forms for the racing events and conformation match. Payment for the racing events and the match is not required in advance; if you email your entries by the early entry deadline, you are welcome to pay your fees at the pre-entry price the morning of the event.

For the ASFA trial only, please see the special instructions in the ASFA premium list. ASFA pre-entries must be paid by the pre-entry deadline. ASFA has strict requirements about entries, and that is why the procedure is different for ASFA entries than for the other events. Thanks for your cooperation!

Electronic payment may be sent via paypal to paypal@wwwhippet.org. Credit and debit card payments gladly accepted, but you must agree to pay the paypal fee. See the ASFA premium list for detailed instructions on how to submit your payment so that WWWA does not incur any paypal fees.

All checks should be made payable to WWWA. If you wish, you may write one check for all events and enclose it with your ASFA entries, with a note explaining what you're paying for. You may also combine all entry fees in one paypal payment, again, with an explanation of your payment.

NOTRA: Open to any Afghan Hound, Basenji, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Irish Wolfhound, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Sloughi, Whippet or provisional breed (Portuguese Podengo and Magyar Agar) one year or older on the day of the meet.

General Rules

All racers must wear muzzles. All racers will be boxed unless the race committee deems the boxes will not accommodate a breed in attendance. Entries will only be accepted from hounds qualified to race. Hounds must be registered with the appropriate race organization to participate. To register in advance see the appropriate website (NAWRA: <http://www.nawra.com>; LGRA: <http://www.lgra.org>; NOTRA: <http://www.notra.org>) for more information. Registration will be offered the day of the meet; for **each organization**, please bring a copy of hound's registration and the \$2 registration fee. However, pre-registration is greatly appreciated by the race!

ASFA regulations prohibit the field secretary from accepting conditional entries, including phone, unpaid, or non-certified or non-waivered FTE (First Time Entered) entries. Completed entries, with fees, must be received by Early Entry deadline.

Certification runs will be offered before the trial, limited to 12 runs, at the cost of \$10.00 per dog. You **must** pre-arrange certification runs with the Field Secretary (first come, first served) and **must** provide your own by-dog. Hounds certifying may enter the trial at early-entry fee only if paperwork is received at the secretary's table by 9:00 a.m. the day of the trial.

No one will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the field chairman, except the appointed field committee. A \$5.00 fine will be charged to anybody caught not picking up after their dog or leaving garbage on the field. Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

These rules will be strictly enforced.

(Early inspection will be conducted after the start of trial hours and before the official roll call time – you are encouraged, but not required, to inspect your hounds early; hounds not present by the completion of roll call will be marked absent.)

Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzois, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Whippets and Provisional breeds, if any, may be entered in the regular stakes. Limited stake breeds, if any, are entered in the Limited Stake and currently include purebred Chart Polskis, Galgo Españols, Magyar Agars, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Portuguese Podengos and Silken Windhounds.

All entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with AKC, UKC, NGA, FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a Critique Registration Number (CRN) from the SPDBS. Dogs with an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or a Purebred Alternate Listing (PAL) from the AKC shall be considered registered with that body. Limited and/or Provisional stake entries shall be individually registered with the appropriate registry. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with a hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for Greyhounds registered with the NGA registry.

Regular Stakes Offered

All hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited stakes for the first time must include a completed certification form or waiver (all breeds) and a copy of the hound's registration certificate with their entry (waived for NGA Greyhounds only).

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion.

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible hound whose age is at least six years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least five years, and Rhodesian Ridgebacks and Whippets whose age shall be at least seven years. Points & placements go toward V-FCH & V-LCM titles.

LIMITED STAKE: Any eligible sighthound of a Limited or Provisional stake breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

SINGLES STAKE: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

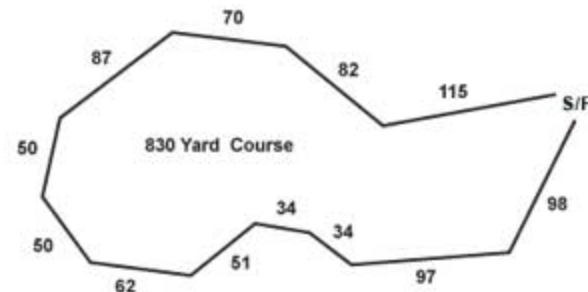
BEST IN FIELD will be offered.

General Rules & Guidelines

All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial. Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more. Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call. Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered. Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Hound certification runs will be offered before the trial (see front cover for details). Battery-powered DRAG lure machines will be used, with backup equipment on site. The lure will consist of white plastic and/or fur strips. A \$5.00 fine will be collected from the handler of any non-competing hound running loose on the field during the course in progress, and from any person not cleaning up after his/her hound. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the site during trial hours. Persons exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct detrimental to WWWW, ASFA, Tacoma Polo Club, any hound, or other person will be asked to leave the trial site and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

The club reserves the right to alter the course as require by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial . The course will be reversed for finals and again for run-offs or at the discretion of the judges.

FACILITIES INFORMATION

The Polo Field will be used for polo (imagine that!) on Saturday and Sunday and the regular parking area will be reserved for the sole use of the polo participants on those days. Though there will not be polo on Monday, and we'll have use of the combined fields for the ASFA trial, the start/finish and parking will stay on the practice field side so that Versatility Weekend overnight campers won't have to move.

In 2006, ASFA Operational Policy #287 was revised as follows:

"Fax and email entries may be accepted by Field Trial Secretaries, but only in such cases as payment (e.g., by Paypal or similar service, or by credit card) is received at the time the entry is submitted."

Please read the following instructions carefully:

- ✓ Send entry fees via Paypal. All forms of Paypal payments, including credit cards, are accepted. In order for WFWA to avoid incurring paypal fees, payment **MUST** be made via the "personal" tab under payment options.. To send your entry fees:
 - ✓ Login to your Paypal account and click on the "Send Money" tab
 - ✓ Enter paypal@wwwhippet.org as the recipient.
 - ✓ Enter your total entry fees in US dollars.
 - ✓ Click on the **PERSONAL** tab and choose "Payment Owed"
 - ✓ **IF** you are funding your payment as an instant transfer from a confirmed bank account attached to your Paypal account, there will be no Paypal fee charged to you or to WFWA.
 - ✓ **IF** you are funding your payment with a credit or debit card, you **MUST** check off the box agreeing to pay the fee. **If you choose a payment method that charges WFWA a Paypal fee, the FTS will reject your payment and you will have to try again!**
- ✓ Your **entries** MUST be submitted on official ASFA entry forms. You may use your own pre-filled official ASFA entry forms, the generic MS Word or PDF versions available on the ASFA website (<http://www.asfa.org>) or the the entry form available in the premium list.
- ✓ Email your completed entry forms and any required documents (e.g. certification/waiver forms and registration papers for FTEs) to serendipitywhippets@gmail.com. Your entries **MUST**:
 - ✓ Be sent **AFTER** payment is completed per instructions above.
 - ✓ Contain an original signature (not a typed signature in lieu of original)
 - ✓ Be accompanied by all associated paperwork (e.g. certification forms/waivers and AKC registration for FTEs)
 - ✓ Be submitted on official ASFA entry forms
 - ✓ Be emailed with a date/time stamp before the Early Entry deadline (6:00 p.m., Thursday, May 27, 2010).
- ✓ Receipt of all electronic entries **WILL** be acknowledged by the FTS.
- ✓ Sorry, electronic payment is for early entries only. We cannot accept credit card payments the day of the trial.

Versatility Scoring

Special prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the ASFA trial for the highest ranked hound in each breed entered in all four areas of competition:

Sprint Racing (NAWRA *or* LGRA *or* ISWS)

and

Oval Racing (NOTRA *or* ISWS)

and

Lure Coursing (ASFA)

and

Conformation Match

Any hound may be entered in any event or combination of events, but only hounds that compete in all four areas of competition will be eligible for versatility awards. To be eligible, hounds must complete all four events, without dismissal or disqualification. Hounds scratched from any event, for any reason, are ineligible for Versatility awards.

SPRINT: Each hound competing in either the NAWRA or the LGRA is ranked by order of finish in the final results.

OVAL: Each hound competing in the NOTRA is ranked by order of finish in the final results.

MATCH: For the conformation match, Versatility entrants will compete in a separate class (divided by breed), which will be ranked from top to bottom.

ASFA: Each hound competing in the ASFA trial is ranked by total score (total of prelim + final), regardless of stake. For example:

Open stake (score):

Rank 1 dog A 303

Rank 4 dog B 297

Rank 5 dog C 295

FCH stake:

Rank 2 dog D 299

Rank 3 dog E 298

Rank 7.5 dog F 290

Veteran Stake:

Rank 6 dog G 292

Rank 7.5 dog H 290

Rank 9 dog I 285

For the tied scores, the ranks are averaged, e.g. the 7 and 8 ranks above are averaged at 7.5.

VERSATILITY: Each entrant's ranks from the four events will be summed. The hound with the **LOWEST** score in each breed will win the Versatility award for that breed. For example, a perfect score, earned by the highest ranked dog in each event, would be a 4.
