Driving Directions:

From the North: From I-5 take exit #127 (Hwy 512 Puyallup exit) towards Puyallup. Take the Pacific Ave exit (Hwy 7) and turn right. Go south on Pacific Ave approximately 5 miles to the Roy "Y" and bear right on WA-507/ Spanaway McKenna Hwy. Go 1.2 miles and turn slight left onto 8th Ave. Go 5.2 miles and turn left into the first driveway after the flashing yellow light at the 288th St. intersection. Follow dirt road to the club house and find a place to park.

From the South: Take I-5 exit 88A (Tenino exit) and follow to Yelm. Turn right at the stop light and follow to McKenna. 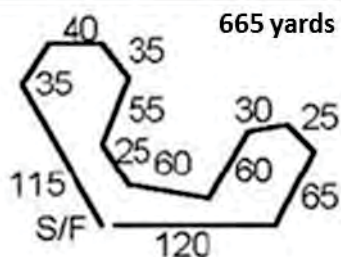

Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzois, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Whippets and Provisional breeds, if any, may be entered in the regular stakes. Limited stake breeds, if any, are entered in the Limited Stake and currently include purebred Chart Polskis, Galgo Españols, Magyar Agars, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Portuguese Podengos and Silken Windhounds.

All entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with AKC, UKC, NGA, FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a Critique Registration Number (CRN) from the SPDBS. Dogs with an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or a Purebred Alternate Listing (PAL) from the AKC shall be considered registered with that body. Limited and/or Provisional stake entries shall be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with a hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for Greyhounds registered with the NGA registry.

Regular Stakes Offered

All hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited stakes for the first time must include a completed certification form or waiver (all breeds) and a copy of the hound's registration certificate with their entry (waived for NGA Greyhounds only).

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion.

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible hound whose age is at least six years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least five years, and Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Whippets and Afghan Hounds whose age shall be at least seven years. Points & placements go toward V-FCH & V-LCM titles.

LIMITED STAKE: Any eligible sighthound of a Limited or Provisional stake breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

SINGLES STAKE: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

BEST IN FIELD will be offered.

Conditions of Entry

All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial. Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more. Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call. Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered. Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Hound certification runs will be offered before the trial (see front cover for details).

Equipment

Battery-powered DRAG lure machines will be used, with backup equipment on site. The lure will consist of white plastic and/or fur strips.

Additional Information

A \$5.00 fine will be collected from the handler of any non-competing hound running loose on the field during the course in progress, and from any person not cleaning up after his/her hound. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the site during trial hours. Persons exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct detrimental to WWWW, ASFA, Tacoma Polo Club, any hound, or other person will be asked to leave the trial site and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

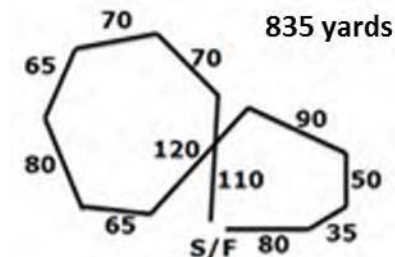

All entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with AKC, UKC, NGA, FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a Critique Registration Number (CRN) from the SPDBS. Dogs with an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or a Purebred Alternate Listing (PAL) from the AKC shall be considered registered with that body. Limited and/or Provisional stake entries shall be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

Eligibility for the Regional Invitational

Any hound that has earned at least 1 ASFA point is eligible to enter. For a Limited Stake or Provisional breed to be eligible, the entered hound must have received a placement, with competition. All points or placements must be earned by the closing date of the event. Any hound entered in the Single Stake does not need prior ASFA experience. An eligible hound may be entered in any number of Regional Invitationals.

Regular Stakes Offered

All hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited stakes for the first time must include a completed certification form or waiver (all breeds) and a copy of the hound's registration certificate with their entry (waived for NGA Greyhounds only).

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion.

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible hound whose age is at least six years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least five years, and Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Whippets and Afghan Hounds whose age shall be at least seven years. Points & placements go toward V-FCH & V-LCM titles.

LIMITED STAKE: Any eligible sighthound of a Limited or Provisional stake breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

SINGLES STAKE: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

BEST IN FIELD will be offered.

Non-Regular Stakes Offered

KENNEL STAKE: For two hounds of the same breed, designated at the time of entry, entered in one of the regular stakes, owned and kenneled by the same person.

BREEDER STAKE: For two hounds of the same breed, designated at the time of entry, entered in one of the regular stakes, bred by the same individual.

NOTE: An owner/breeder may have more than one entry in the kennel or breeder stakes as long as the two hounds comprising each entry are properly identified at the time of entry. A hound may only be part of any one kennel and one breeder stake entry. Please send in Breeder/Kennel Stake form indicating pairs along with properly marked entry forms and fees.

Conditions of Entry

- ⇒ All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial.
- ⇒ Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more.
- ⇒ Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call.
- ⇒ Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.
- ⇒ Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake.
- ⇒ Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched.
- ⇒ All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.

Equipment

- ⇒ Battery-powered DRAG lure machines will be used, with backup equipment on site.
- ⇒ The lure will consist of white plastic and/or fur strips.

Additional Information

- ⇒ A \$5.00 fine will be collected from the handler of any non-competing hound running loose on the field during the course in progress, and from any person not cleaning up after his/her hound.
- ⇒ No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the site during trial hours.
- ⇒ Persons exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct detrimental to WWWA, ASFA, Tacoma Polo Club, any hound, or other person will be asked to leave the trial site and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

There will be a potluck lunch both days. Please bring a dish to share. We will offer prizes for the best dish, so make them good ones!
